

To be eligible for a light-sport repairman certificate, you must:

- ◆ Be at least 18 years old.
- ◆ Read, speak, write, and understand English.
- ◆ Complete the amount of training required for the class of LSA to be maintained.
- ◆ Be a U.S. citizen or be lawfully admitted for permanent residence.

LSA Repairman Course

The rules for Light Sport were issued in 2004 and included certification of aircraft, pilots and repairman. This part of aviation has had a significant growth and is projected to continue. Many aviation enthusiasts are finding LSA aircraft to be a cheaper way to get into the air, both for long time pilots and those just getting into flying.

Virginia Aviation offers the LSA repairman's course with maintenance rating (LSRM) on weight shift control aircraft, as well as E-LSA inspection courses in Airplane, WSC and PPC.

The LSRM course provides both classroom and hands-on training necessary to obtain a LSA repairman's rating.

This rating allows the holder to perform the annual condition inspection, the 100-hour inspections (if the aircraft is used for hire) and the maintenance on S-LSA and E-LSA aircraft. In addition, we will be offering the fixed wing LSA class in the near future.

Our E-LSA with inspection rating courses provide the required training for those who own (or plan to own) an E-LSA aircraft and wish to do their own annual condition inspections.
